The 2020-2021 Fiscal Year stands as a year that reshaped our organization in many ways. MIKE navigated the pandemic's impact on education and health, strengthening our resolve to truly make a difference in the lives of the students we serve. And you helped make it possible!



We launched new programming that responded to the needs of students and mentors. Based on the guidance from the Oregon Department of Education and the schools we serve, MIKE shifted to virtual comprehensive distance learning projects, customized for each school. We asked what was needed, then delivered programming which provided students with meaningful content. MIKE reinforced how students perceive health and provided the tools for them to shape their outcomes.

During this fiscal year, we also transitioned our organization's leadership from a volunteer position to a paid executive director.

We salute the dedication and resilience of our founder, Cheryl Neal, MD, who began this process. Her work, and that of all our governance and programming volunteers, have built MIKE into an organization that we can all be proud of—and one that guides local youth toward a healthy
