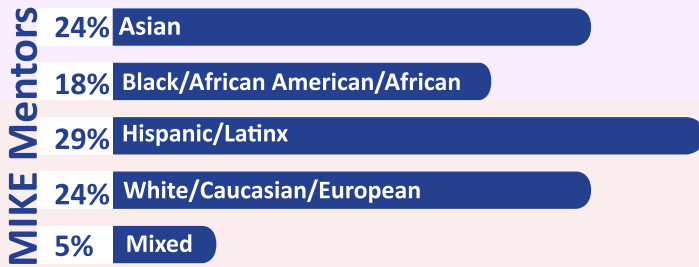

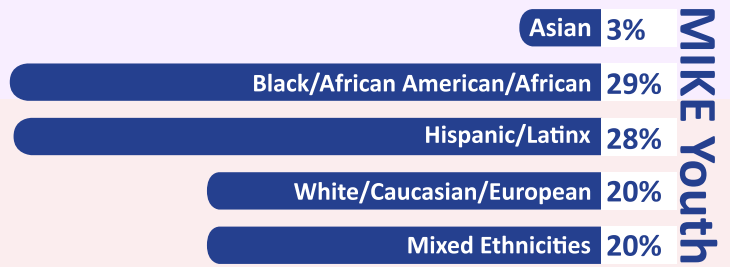
MIKE Program Diversity
